

Administration of New Regents Examinations

A new Regents Examination is developed when there are new academic learning standards, a revision to the learning standards, or a change in test design. Whenever a newly developed exam is administered for the first time, a standard setting meeting must be held to determine the levels of expectation (i.e., cut scores) for classification into each performance level.

Why do new Regents Exams have to be administered early to students?

The early administration of new exams ensures that the raw-to-scale score conversion charts can be prepared and posted no later than the end of exam week in June.
